MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS FOR DENIRO FOOTWEAR

The DeNiro Boot company is famous for its quality, style and innovative design and has become a market leader through research and attention to detail. All DeNiro Boots are handcrafted in their own factory in Italy and are subjected to rigorous testing and quality control to ensure they last for years and years.

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HOW TO MEASURE FOR A PERFECT FIT



To get the perfect fit, you'll need three pieces of information:

➤ your **foot size**, your **calf size** and the **boot height**

1. Wear the breeches or jodhpurs and socks you're most likely to wear with your new boots.
2. Sit down on a hard chair, and put your feet flat on the floor with your legs at a 90 degree angle, then enlist the help of a friend to measure round your calf at the widest point.
3. Then, stand up and keep your heel on the floor, bending your leg to imitate your riding position.
4. Measure from back of your knee, just under the fold of the joint, down to the floor.

Important Notes:

Measuring with a bend in the leg will take into account that your boots will drop and will start to 'give' slightly at the ankle and sit a little lower as you wear them in.

Your new boots will also give a little round the calf, so when you put them on at first they should feel snug around the leg.

- Hold the tape measure close to the body
- Do not insert fingers between body and tape measure as this will give an inaccurate measurement
- Do not add any extra to the measurement as this too will give an inaccurate measurement
